First Reading: Ezekiel 33.7-9

A reading from book of the prophet Ezekiel.

The word of the Lord came to me: "So you, O mortal, I have made a sentinel for the house of Israel; whenever you hear a word from my mouth, you shall give them warning from me. "If I say to the wicked, 'O wicked ones, you shall surely die,' and you do not speak to warn the wicked to turn from their ways, the wicked shall die in their iniquity, but their blood I will require at your hand. "But if you warn the wicked to turn from their ways, and they do not turn from their ways, the wicked shall die in their iniquity, but you will have saved your life."

Responsorial Psalm: Psalm 95.1-2, 6-7ab, 7c-9 (R.7c+8a)

R. If today you hear God's voice, harden not your hearts.

O come, let us sing to the Lord; let us make a joyful noise to the rock of our salvation! Let us come into his presence with thanksgiving; let us make a joyful noise to him with songs of praise! **R.**

O come, let us worship and bow down, let us kneel before the Lord, our Maker! For he is our God, and we are the people of his pasture, and the sheep of his hand. **R.**

O that today you would listen to his voice! Do not harden your hearts, as at Meribah, as on the day at Massah in the wilderness, when your ancestors tested me, and put me to the proof, though they had seen my work. **R.**

Second Reading: Romans 13.8-10

A reading from the letter of Paul to the Romans.

Owe no one anything, except to love one another; for the one who loves another has fulfilled the law. The commandments, "You shall not commit adultery; You shall not murder; You shall not steal; You shall not covet"; and any other commandment, are summed up in this word, "Love your neighbour as yourself." Love does no wrong to a neighbour; therefore, love is the fulfilling of the law.

Gospel: Matthew 18.15-20

A reading from the holy gospel according to Matthew.

Jesus spoke to his disciples. "If your brother or sister sins against you, go and point out the fault when the two of you are alone. If the brother or sister listens to you, you have regained that one. But if you are not listened to, take one or two others along with you, so that every word may be confirmed by the evidence of two or three witnesses. If the brother or sister refuses to listen to them, tell it to the church; and if the offender refuses to listen even to the church, let such a one be to you as a Gentile and a tax collector. "Truly I tell you, whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven. Again, truly I tell you, if two of you agree on earth about anything you ask, it will be done for you by my Father in heaven. For where two or three are gathered in my name, I am there among them."

GOSPEL REFLECTION – ‘Boundaries and Juries

Our Lord acknowledged that the community he was establishing had to set boundaries. Who is to decide who is within or outside those boundaries? In today's Gospel, Our Lord teaches that a nuanced step by step process should be invoked. First, there is private conversation, then slightly extended to bring in two or three others, then a sort of church community jury before a person is put beyond the pale. Our Lord promises to be with them to help guide their decision. We all know of marriages which are fractured and where one partner has found intimacy and security in a second (civil) marriage. Pope Francis did not suggest that the second marriage be regarded as valid. But he suggested a process of discernment to allow a divorced person to receive 'the Eucharist . . . a powerful medicine and nourishment for the weak.' Could a jury of ordinary Catholic lay people help make that discerning judgement, and then advise the Bishop as to the next step? We could pause for a moment to ponder the promise: 'Where two or three are gathered into my name, I am there with them.'

Commento di Papa Benedetto XVI, Angelus, 4 Settembre 2011

«Se il tuo fratello commetterà una colpa contro di te, va' e ammoniscilo fra te e lui solo; se ti ascolterà, avrai guadagnato il tuo fratello; se non ascolterà, prendi ancora con te una o due persone, perché ogni cosa sia risolta sulla parola di due o tre testimoni. Se poi non ascolterà costoro, dillo alla comunità; se non ascolterà neanche la comunità, sia per te come il pagano e il pubblicano. In verità io vi dico: tutto quello che legherete sulla terra sarà legato in cielo, e tutto quello che scioglierete sulla terra sarà sciolto in cielo. In verità io vi dico ancora: se due di voi sulla terra si metteranno d'accordo per chiedere qualunque cosa, il Padre mio che è nei cieli gliela concederà. Perché dove sono due o tre riuniti nel mio nome, lì sono io in mezzo a loro». Parola del Signore.

Se mio fratello commette una colpa contro di me, io devo usare carità verso di lui e, prima di tutto, parlargli personalmente, facendogli presente che ciò che ha detto o fatto non è buono. Questo modo di agire si chiama correzione fraterna: essa è mossa dall'amore per il fratello. E se il fratello non mi ascolta? Gesù nel Vangelo odierno indica una gradualità: prima tornare a parlargli con altre due o tre persone, per aiutarlo meglio a rendersi conto di quello che ha fatto; se, malgrado questo, egli respinge ancora l'osservazione, bisogna dirlo alla comunità; e se non ascolta neppure la comunità, occorre fargli percepire il distacco che lui stesso ha provocato. Ciascuno, consapevole dei propri limiti e difetti, è chiamato ad accogliere la correzione fraterna e ad aiutare gli altri con questo particolare servizio. Un altro frutto della carità nella comunità è la preghiera concorde. Dice Gesù: "dove sono due o tre riuniti nel mio nome, lì sono io in mezzo a loro".
