# The Bible and I

"Your Word is a lamp for my feet, a light for my path" (psalm 109:105)

# Lent - Fasting practices

We are fasting and praying during Lent. It's an old tradition. In the Old Testament, there are many examples, here are some:

**Moses:** Before receiving the stone tablets with God's commandments, Moses fasted for 40 days on Mount Sinai. (Deuteronomy 9:9-18)

**David**: After committing adultery with Bathsheba, David repented, but there were still consequences. When their child fell seriously ill, David fasted and prayed fervently, hoping for God's mercy. (2 Samuel 12:1-23)

**Elijah**: The prophet Elijah faced threats from Queen Jezebel after his victory over the prophets of Baal on Mount Carmel. In fear, he fled to the wilderness, where he fasted for **40 days**. (1 Kings 19:4-8)

#### In the New Testament,

Jesus is an example,

Before his public ministry, he was led by the Spirit into wilderness and fasted for forty days and was tempted by the devil. (Mark 1:15)

Jesus warns against fasting to show off or seeking human praise. Fasting should be done secret and God knows and will reward. (Mathew 6:16-18)

#### In Church's tradition:

St. Augustine, on the subject of fasting says,

"Fasting cleanses the soul, raises the mind, subjects one's flesh to the spirit, renders the heart contrite and humble, scatters the clouds of concupiscence, quenches the fire of lust, kindles the true light of chastity."

Papal teachings: In his Lenten message in 2009, Pope Benedict XVI said,

"Fasting represents an important ascetical practice, a spiritual arm to do battle against every possible disordered attachment to ourselves. Freely chosen detachment from the pleasure of food and other material goods helps the disciple of Christ to control the appetites of nature, weakened by original sin, whose negative effects impact the entire human person."

Reading recommended: Isaiah 58:1-14 – Prophet Isaiah explains about true fasting to people of his time.
