## Second Sunday of Easter - Year B

### *Divine Mercy Sunday*

My dear people of God, Easter greetings and Blessings of the Risen Lord to all of you from Fr Santosh.

We have solemnly celebrated the feast of Easter and the very next Sunday of Easter we would be celebrating the feast of the Divine Mercy which concludes the Easter Octave.

Faustina Kowalska, a Polish nun, now a saint, reported visions and visitations from Jesus and conversations with him. He asked her to paint the vision of his merciful divinity being poured from his Sacred Heart and specifically asked for a feast of Divine Mercy to be established on the first Sunday after Easter Sunday, so that mankind would take refuge in him: "I want the image solemnly blessed on the first Sunday after Easter, and I want it to be venerated publicly so that every soul may know about it." — Jesus' words, Diary 341



The devotion was actively promoted by Pope John Paul II, now a saint. On April 30, 2000, the Canonization of Faustina Kowalska took place and the second Sunday of Easter was officially designated as the Sunday of the Divine Mercy in the General Roman Calendar. On April 22, 2001, which was one year after establishing Divine Mercy Sunday, Pope John Paul II re-emphasized its message in the resurrection context of Easter: Jesus said to Faustina: "Humanity will never find peace until it turns with trust to Divine Mercy". Divine Mercy! This is the Easter gift that the Church receives from the risen Christ and offers to humanity.

The feast of Divine Mercy, according to the diary of St Faustina, receives from Jesus the biggest promises of grace related to the Devotion of Divine Mercy, in particular that a person who goes to sacramental confession (the confession may take place some days before) and receives holy communion on that day, shall obtain the total expiation of all sins and punishment.

This feast is all the more relevant in our times as the humanity continues to go away from the Merciful God through sinful ways and so praying for the Mercy of God on the humanity is all the more needed than ever before. As we celebrate this feast let's pray that God be merciful to us and also to those who are in need of His great mercy and may the Devotion to Divine Mercy continue to spread far and wide.

## UPDATED COVID SAFE PLANS

I wish to thank all the parishioners for the cooperation and support you have extended to us in managing the regulations of SA Government with regard to Covid safety.

**Effective Wednesday (31<sup>st</sup> March 2021), the SA Government has relaxed the COVID Safe rules to allow 100% occupancy at our places of worship, provided that all wear face masks, as a prevention measure.**

### Church services:

- ◆ St. Augustine's Church – 1000 pp
- ◆ Holy Family - 400 pp
- ◆ St Finbar's Church – 120 pp
