Rosary

My dear people of God, greetings and good wishes from Fr Santosh. Traditionally the month of October is considered as the month of Rosary and on the 7th of October we celebrate the feast of Our Lady of Rosary. Hence I found it apt to write a reflection on Rosary. This feast was instituted by Pope St Pius V in thanksgiving for the great naval victory over the Turks at the battle of Lepanto in the year 1570, a favour due to the recitation of the Rosary. This victory saved Europe from being overrun by the forces of Islam.



The word Rosary means a "Crown of Roses". Our Lady has revealed that each time one says a Hail Mary, one is giving her a beautiful rose and that completion of each Rosary makes her a beautiful crown of roses. The rose is the queen of flowers, and so the Rosary is the rose of all devotions.

Before I came to Adelaide last year from India I was the Provincial Secretary having my residence and office in the Provincial House. This house being the mother house for all the MSFS priests of our province and also the house of governance it had to be the house of prayer. The residents including the Provincial knew the power of prayer and we used to begin the day with exposition of the Blessed Sacrament at 6am followed by Holy Mass and every evening we used to come together to recite Rosary. Out of five members in the community, three were Doctorate holders in Theology from foreign universities. In spite of their expertise in Theology (Study of God) they were convinced of the power of Rosary which humbled me personally. The more we know God, the more respect it would generate for Mother Mary. That's what my life with these great doctorate holders taught me. My love for rosary again was strengthened when I witnessed in some parishes in Adelaide a few people voluntarily coming together to pray the Rosary.

Rosary has a long tradition in the Church. Our Lady asked the children of Fatima to pray the Rosary every day for peace in the world. The need for praying for the peace still continues. As the battle against Turks was won by the power of reciting Rosary, so each individual can win the constant battle against evil and it's temptations through the power of Rosary. Some people feel that recitation of the Rosary is the 1950's spirituality. They have their own reasons for that.

What is your attitude for the Rosary?

- Please arrive at least 20-25 minutes earlier to the scheduled time of the Mass.

• **COVID-19 MARSHALS AT ALL MASSES**

The government has directed that as from 21st of August 2020 we must have a COVID Marshal. The COVID Marshal's role is to ensure that the sites COVID Safe Plan and local COVID prevention plans, policies or protocols are implemented as best as possible and takes all reasonable action to ensure that all staff, patrons, contractors and other people on the site follow these rules.

As COVID Marshals are required under the Emergency Management (Public Activities (COVID-19) Direction 2020, the church will be subject to compliance inspections by authorities and non-compliance with requirements can be subjected to penalties.

While we do not always like change, this change has been put in place to protect you and your families. We would respectfully ask that you comply with any requests asked of you by the COVID Marshal.
