UPDATED COVID SAFE PLANS

I wish to thank all the parishioners for the cooperation and support you have extended to us in managing the regulations of SA Government with regard to Covid safety.

Effective Wednesday (31st March 2021),

the SA Government has relaxed the COVID Safe rules

to allow +75% and up to 100% occupancy at our places of worship,

PROVIDED THAT ALL WEAR FACE MASKS,

as a prevention measure.

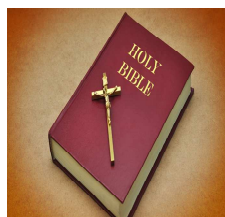
Association of the Lay Canossians
