A REFLECTION ABOUT THE PROCESS OF 'APPRECIATIVE INQUIRY'

When I read about 'appreciative inquiry', my first reaction was that 'been there, done that!' However, with additional time to reflect, I got to appreciate that what is being proposed is that of being open to discovery and not be blinkered by pre-conceptions or pre-definitions of future focus objectives or targets. Many of us would relate to our past training or experiences about goal setting and goal oriented management techniques, however, what is being advocated in the process of 'appreciative inquiry' is to let the results of the listening lead to the determination of what needs to be actioned or explored further.

I sort of liked the emphasis given on positive focus for the enquiry, although I must admit to the tendency to also take into account the negative aspects found during the enquiry. I am too much a realist to totally ignore the negative side of things. But yes, it is good to have a greater predilection to life-giving stories for these would be encouraging and strengthening to both the listener and the story teller. It would affirm the story-teller and encourage/ enthuse/ inspire the listener. Positive reinforcement to all involved parties is life-giving.

In our parish groups, we do explore stories from sources external and from within the group, by sharing our stories. However, we can fall into the trap of limiting our vision to what is presented to us, rather than going out there to the people where they worship, where they work, where they have their leisure, in the schools and homes and collectively do an exercise in appreciative enquiry. We can have a sense in general of what the people are wanting, but it would be good to further engage in person-to-person conversations to explore their thoughts of what would be good for the community and their views on what is the future of the parish.

Granted, we have the current challenge of the COVID pandemic. Granted that, there are plans in place for a Plenary Meeting of the Catholic Church in Australia and that there were conversations, consultations made and opinions collated from the people all over Australia for consideration and discussion during the forthcoming Plenary meeting. Granted, we have had consultations in the Parish and that we are gradually implementing some of the outcomes of these consultations. Nevertheless, we have to keep the conversation going.

Notwithstanding this, let us pray for continued guidance by the Holy Spirit; and let us hope that these things that are being done shall be for the good of all, and to the greater glory of God.

ONLINE PUBLIC LECTURE BY MONSIGNOR KEVIN W. IRWIN

Monday 17th May 2021

**"Liturgy and Sacraments in a COVID World:
Renewal not Restoration".**

Monsignor Irwin held the Walter J. Schmitz Chair of Liturgical Studies (2000-2015) at Catholic University of America where he is currently an Ordinary Research Professor and where he has previously served as Dean of the School of Theology and Religious Studies (2005-2011). He is the author of over twenty books and seventy journal articles.

Here is a description of the lecture topic: Restrictions on in-person worship during the pandemic have challenged parishes to find other ways to connect through the use of technology. While some successful innovations have emerged during this period, some problematic liturgical practices have also been uncovered which indicate that further work is still needed in many places to implement Vatican II's liturgical reforms fully. Kevin Irwin's analysis of the current situation will highlight a positive path forward.
