**Easter: A Time for Reflection – A Renewed

Pietro allora uscì insieme all'altro discepolo e si recarono al sepolcro. Correvano insieme tutti e due, ma l'altro discepolo corse più veloce di Pietro e giunse per primo al sepolcro. Si chinò, vide i teli posati là, ma non entrò. Giunse intanto anche Simon Pietro, che lo seguiva, ed entrò nel sepolcro e osservò i teli posati là, e il sudario che era stato sul suo capo non posato là con i teli, ma avvolto in un luogo a parte. Allora entrò anche l'altro discepolo, che era giunto per primo al sepolcro, e vide e credette. Infatti non avevano ancora compreso la Scrittura, che cioè egli doveva risorgere dai morti. **Parola del Signore.**

Gesù è Colui che spezza le catene e riporta la libertà! I tempi passano, gli uomini periscono nella loro umanità, ricchi o poveri, sconosciuti o famosi, potenti o miseri; ma Cristo Gesù è Colui che rimane in eterno, che vive nella sua Risurrezione, Verità immutabile che non può essere cancellata: Evento veritiero, concreto, che nella sua vittoria spezza sempre e continuamente le catene che il demonio forma, per ricondurre a libertà. I discepoli di Emmaus percorrono la strada e sono oppressi dalla tristezza: si pongono domande sulla Persona che non riescono a comprendere, sono impauriti dalle tenebre che incrociano nel percorso del loro cammino... Quanti di noi camminano per la strada dell'esistenza senza capire il senso della loro nascita e dove vanno, cosa c'è oltre il termine di essa, e si pongono domande, hanno paura... Eppure guardate cosa accade ai discepoli: all'incontro con il Risorto che si affianca al loro peregrinare sconsolato, alla sua Parola si rallegrano e si accende il cuore; allo spezzare del Pane si illuminano, pur nell'oscurità della notte iniziata, ed hanno luce piena. Solo se l'accogliamo nel nostro cammino e ci poniamo a fianco a Gesù, noi avremo sapienza, conoscenza e motivazione del nostro vivere.
